1. LOVE’S FIRST WORD - *“Jesus said, Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do” (Luke 23:34, ESV).*

“Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you” (Matthew 5:44, ESV).

“For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you, but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses” (Matthew 6:14-15, ESV).

2. LOVE’S SECOND WORD – *“Then he said, ‘Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.’” And he said to him, “Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise” (Luke 23:42-43, ESV).*

“The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise” (Psalm 51:17, ESV).

“And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ” (Ephesians 3:17-18, NIV).

3. LOVE’S THIRD WORD – *“He said to his mother, “Woman, behold, your son!” Then he said to the disciple, “Behold, your mother!” And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home” (John 19:26-27, ESV).*

“‘Woman, behold, your son!’ Then he said to the disciple, ‘Behold, your mother!’” (John 19:26-27, ESV).

“Honor your father and your mother” (Exodus 20:12, ESV). Paul wrote to Timothy, “But if anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for members of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever” (1 Timothy 5:8, ESV).

4. LOVE’S FOURTH WORD – *“And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, ‘Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?’ that is, “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?’” (Matthew 27:46, ESV).*

“My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, from the words of my groaning? O my God, I cry by day, but you do not answer, and by night, but I find no rest. Yet you are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel. In you our fathers trusted; they trusted, and you delivered them. To you they cried and were rescued; in you they trusted and were not put to shame (Psalm 22:1-5, ESV).

“For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith” (1 John 5:4, ESV).

5. LOVE’S FIFTH WORD – *“I am thirsty” (John 19:28, ESV).*

“And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth” (John 1:14, ESV).

“And I came to the exiles at Tel-abib, who were dwelling by the Chebar canal, and I sat where they were dwelling. And I sat there overwhelmed among them seven days” (Ezekiel 3:15, ESV).

“For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin” (Hebrews 4:15, ESV).

“Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call his name Immanuel” (Matthew 1:23, ESV).

6. LOVE’S SIXTH WORD – *“It is finished” (John 19:30, ESV).*

“I glorified you on earth, having accomplished the work that you gave me to do” (John 17:4, ESV).

“And on the seventh day God finished his work that he had done, and he rested on the seventh day from all his work that he had done” (Genesis 2:2, ESV).

“It is finished” (John 19:30, ESV).

“It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end” (Revelation 21:6, ESV).
